


Updates to the MAP WebETest Interface

1. Trainers and/or Providers are required to check the MAP Registry prior to training candidates to ensure that they are eligible to train for MAP. In addition, for individuals who have a record of “abuse” in the MAP Registry and are not eligible to test under the MAP program, we have created a block in the system to prevent the creation of a record for those individuals in WebETest. If an attempt is made to enter an individual into the system who has a record of “abuse” in the MAP Registry, a message will be received stating that the candidate has a record of “abuse” in the registry when the “Submit Updates” button is clicked. (see below). No further progress can be made to create a record in WebETest. If you have any further questions about the individual look up their record in the registry or contact D&SDT.

If a candidate has successfully completed training within the previous 12 months and that information has been entered into WebETest, the candidate will be required to exhaust all testing attempts based on that training before any further training can be entered into their record even if they have changed employers within that time period. Completing another full training after one or two failures cannot be used to extend the original one year deadline for a candidate to complete testing.
