Effective July 12, 2023, the Michigan Department of Licensing & Regulatory Affairs, Bureau of Community and Health Systems, will transition the Nurse Aide Registry from Headmaster, L.L.P., to Michigan Nurse Aide, Training, and Enforcement System (MI-NATES), a new software program with the State of Michigan. This system will be active July 26, 2023. This transition will impact new applicants as well as current registered nurse aides.

- Electronic Submission and Payments for Nurse Aide Applications and Renewals
- Printing your Certificate of Registration
- Reviewing or Updating Your Registration Information
